PRINCIPALITY of NORAUTHWIK

1. DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS:

1.1 Establish and maintain peaceful, collaborative, and cooperative relationships with other organizations and/or MicroNations who support and show expression of the Principles of NorAuthwik.

1.2 Promote cultural exchange to foster mutual understanding and respect, while fostering a sense of unity, emphasizing NorAuthwik's commitment to self-expression, mutual respect, and unity through collaboration.

2. TRADE AND ECONOMIC POLICY:

2.1 Encourage trade agreements that benefit the economic and informative growth of all parties involved.

2.2 Support local businesses by negotiating favorable terms with other organizations, entities, and MicroNations.

3. ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY:

3.1 Collaborate with other nations to address global environmental challenges, promoting sustainable practices and green technologies.

3.2 Implement community-driven environmental initiatives to foster sustainability and ensure the enhancement of protection for our environments, encouraging our allies to do the same.

4. HUMAN RIGHTS AND HUMANITARIAN AID:

4.1 We advocate for human rights and support international efforts to combat human rights abuses. Our efforts align with NorAuthwik's foundational principles of social responsibility and community engagement. *Amendment 4.1-2* The Principality of NorAuthwik suspends all relations with nations, entities, or communities that deny or are responsible for human rights violations issuing Government Code "Persona Non Grata" status.

4.2 NorAuthwik will provide humanitarian assistance, if able or relevant, to local communities in need, participating in relief efforts, reflecting NorAuthwik's commitment to volunteerism and community care

5. COMMUNITY CULTIVATION

5.1 The Principality of NorAuthwik encourages a culture where each citizen/member of our community is valued, heard, and inspired to participate.

5.2 The Principality of NorAuthwik recognizes other communities, organizations, and MicroNations with whom we entertain friendly relations, and welcomes them to be part of our community as Friends of NorAuthwik.
